### How it Works

The purpose of the Parity for Disability 100 Club is to raise money to help maintain the charity's services for children and young adults with multiple disabilities.

Each person wanting to join the 100 Club is allocated a number between 1 and 100. The number allocated remains that person's as long as they remain a fully paid up member. The cost is £12 per year and is paid by standing order only.

Once a month, on the first Monday of the month (from Monday 3 April 2006) a draw will take place. One prize will be drawn, valued at 50% of the monies collected the previous month. The prize will be paid by cheque to the winner.

The winner's name will be posted at the Parity office and on the Parity web site, and publicised via the Parity quarterly newsletter.
